**New Business**

Alex Pierce from the Nunda Planning Board to speak about the Nunda Comprehensive Plan.

- Nunda Planning Board is the lead agency.
- The members from the town board and village board were chosen based on their background and expertise.
- Nunda started the comprehensive plan process in 2018.
- They had to decide whether to update the current CP or scrap it and start with a new one.
- Alleghany County had money to help towns and villages update their CPs.
- The Livingston County Planning Board has been helpful.
- Genesee Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council is another resource.
- The Nunda CP was last written in 2005.
- Things they talked about in 2012:
  - Alternative energy sources and how to bring money in for this.
  - Travel & tourism - also how to bring money in for this.
  - They tried to find experts in the fields of Travel and tourism as well as alternative energy.
- Alex joined the county planning board to see what the momentum was in the county.

- When writing an original Comprehensive Plan, here are a few things you need to do
  - Identify areas that did not exist or things that no longer exist.
  - Look at the original CP.
  - Start writing.
  - Include pictures
  - Update stats and narratives that you will be keeping in the plan.
  - Eliminate things that are no longer relevant.
  - Look for expert volunteers to help with writing.
  - Have at least two public hearings. Hopefully people will show up for the public hearings.
  - They found a person in the community with a graphic arts background.
  - They used photos of views of the valley, events, ambulance and fire equipment, etc.
  
- Graphic ideas for Dansville
  - Ambulance and fire equipment
  - Hospital and medical specialties
  - Housing -historic districts, neighborhoods, manufactured homes, etc.
  - Downtown
  - Fairy Doors
  - Events
  - Gliders
  - Transportation - airport, 390, rail spur
  - YMCA
  - Government
  - Telecommunications
  - Highlight municipal water and sewer
  - Roads and Highways
  - Utility providers
  - Fuel providers
  - On dwelling solar panels
  - Solar
  - Education - access to GCC
  - Lodging
  - You can also highlight the state parks in the area.
  - Genesee Valley Greenway
  
- Quinn asked how they incorporated the grant language in the plan. Alex said they
- reached out to those who are writing the grants.
- A comprehensive Plan should use visionary language.
- Ann asked how the Livingston County Economic Development is helping them.
- The County Planning Dept can help with wording.
- Ann asked what the plan is for monitoring follow-through.
  - You can use boxes to add names of people who are responsible for completing the assignment
  
- Ann asked if the group will meet after final plan is complete
  - After the final plan is done the next step will be place holders for when the planning board will address how it moves forward with updates and actions.
- The Dansville CPWG will not disband - we will monitor several times a year.
- Giving acknowledgement to individuals who we talk to gives ownership of the plan.

- The Nunda CP went to other groups to talk to them in their meetings.
- The Nunda CP is about 65-70 pages, and includes pictures and verbiage.
- This is a living plan for generations to come.
- Youth groups - get input from kids.
- references to previous comprehensive plans, and airport plans.
- Use census data for stats.
- Is the tax base going up or down?
- Where do we hope to be?
- Main Parts of the Plan:
  - Intro
  - Body
  - Current Pictures
  - References
  - What do we want to see happen
- One challenge for Nunda - a business wanted to expand but infrastructure was not there. Some said, "let's just put it there for them". But is there a vision for other properties to hook on? Those are things you have to think about and plan for.
- We need to hold the power companies accountable for what the power poles look like and clean them up.
- Don't ask AI to photoshop.
- Nunda didn't pay any to help them.
- Quinn asked if they did a community wide survey and how did you implement them:
  - They went to local organizations.
  - Library
  - Post office
  - Clerk's office
  - Distribute to students
  - We could put it in the water bill
  - Shopper
  - website
